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TOOL 1.7 SELF ASSESSMENT: CONSIDERING A CAREER IN A NONTRADITIONAL OCCUPATION

Nontraditional occupations such as CNC operator and maintenance technician offer many rewarding, challenging careers with good wages and advancement opportunities. However, these jobs are not for everyone. This self-assessment can help training program candidates or participants determine if a nontraditional occupation is a good match for them. Questions span career interests (e.g., physically demanding work), working style (e.g., being part of a project team), and logistics (e.g., reliable transportation). Organizations can provide this self-assessment at information sessions before the start of a training program or use it as part of job development services once training is underway. This tool includes both generic questions and occupation-specific questions for construction, trucking, and warehousing.
